1. *Champagne Gremillet* £42.00
*Recently voted best non-vintage Champagne, beating all the better names.
Great value for money, a superb family produced wine.*
2. *Champagne Gremillet half bottle* £25.00
3. *Taittinger Brut* £60.00
Needs little introduction, well made and classic Champagne.
4. *Marquis de la Cour Demi sec or Brut* £17.00
Fresh and very fruity sparkling wine.

White Wines

5. *Bellefontaine Chardonnay* £15.50
An unoaked Chardonnay from southern France with delicious tropical fruit character.
6. *Muscadet Sur Lie Selection du Grand Moulin* £17.00
Crisp and dry white from the Loire Valley. Perhaps the best wine to accompany fish and seafood.
7. *Pinot Blanc Cave de Turckheim* £17.50
Delicate aromas and soft fruit on the palate. An ideal lunchtime wine.
8. *Laroche Diognier* £18.00
Highly aromatic white wine, with peach and apricot fruit flavours.
9. *Domaine Roc de Chateauxvieux Sauvignon Blanc* £18.00
Mouthwateringly fresh and delicate Loire Sauvignon Blanc. The perfect match for goat's cheese.
10. *Macon Uchizy Domaine Talmar* £20.00
Classic Macon flavours of honey and melon. Dry and full flavoured.
11. *Chablis La Colombe* £25.00
Steely dry Chablis with a delicious mineral finish.

Red Wines

12. *Pasquiers Grenache* £15.00
Full flavoured Languedoc red with a spicy finish.
13. *Le Petit St Jacques* £17.00
From Minervois in south west France, an easy drinking fruity red.
14. *Cahors Chateau Pinerai* £18.00
This excellent red is made from the Malbec grape with a little Merlot to soften it. With a few year's bottle age, it is drinking superbly.
15. *Pinot Noir le Beau Chene* £18.00
Light and fruity Pinot Noir with delicate strawberry fruit character.
16. *Cotes du Ventoux Les Hauts de Mont* £18.00
Soft and fruity red with just a hint of oak.
17. *Fleurie La Reine de l'Arenite* £25.00
Silky smooth with cherry and raspberry aromas and flavours.
18. *Cotes du Castillon Château La Grand Maye* £25.00
From the village next to St Emilion, a wine very similar in style and offering tremendous value for money.
19. *Cairanne La Cote Sauvage* £26.00
Taste the sunshine in this rich and robust Rhone red, very similar in style to Chateauneuf du Pape.

20. *Pasquiers Rose* £14.00

Light and fresh dry Rose from the Languedoc region.

21. *Château Riotor Cotes de Provence* £20.00

Classic Provence Rose, deliciously mouth filling dry and full flavoured.

Half Bottles

22. *Cotes du Rhone Les Vignes du Prince ½ bottle* £10.00

Easy drinking mellow red from the banks of the River Rhone.

23. *Chablis Domaine de Bois d'Yver ½ bottle* £12.00

Classic steely dry Chablis.

24. *Muscat de Rivesaltes Domaine Cazes 375ml* £21.00
